

Animosity Games Privacy Policy

Animosity Games aims to have a clear and concise Privacy Policy to allow our customers to make informed decisions as to the use of their information.

Information Collected and Used by Animosity Games:

Animosity Games (AG) collects some information regarding players of our games - this is typically restricted to publicly available information from the players' Facebook (or equivalent) profile such as name, date of birth, gender, and location. AG also collects information as to in-game activities to track usage, improve the Service, and to send targeted in-game offers. Other non-personally-identifiable information such as IP address, cookie information, browser type, and aggregated user data, may also be logged. AG may share such non-personally identifiable information, in aggregate, to third parties.

We may use your e-mail or Facebook (or equivalent) contact details to send information to you regarding product releases, service notifications, and feedback solicitation.

More detailed profile information such as Facebook groups, services, and interests may also be logged, however only with the express 'opt-in' permission of the user. By giving permission to collect such information, the user also gives AG permission to transfer such information to third parties.

AG does not store any information regarding credit cards or other forms, except the minimum necessary information to continue subscription services and payments from third party sites such as PayPal.

From time to time AG may run promotions, offers, sweepstakes or competitions. Users may be requested to enter personally identifiable information such as name, age, gender, interests, purchasing habits etc. By providing such information in such circumstances, you consent to use of such information by AG and any third parties AG shares information with.

Links:

The Service may contain links to third party sites, such as through advertising links. AG is not responsible for the content, practices, or policies of such third party sites. Our Terms of Use and Privacy Policy only govern information collected on this Site.

Use of Anonymity Features:

AG provides certain features to allow anonymous play of our games, and AG makes every effort to ensure that where requested a players' account is unidentifiable. AG cannot guarantee these features will completely protect a users' identity, and cannot be held responsible for feature failure due to third party site changes, Facebook alterations, bugs, User misuse, or other coding and implementation errors. Also, AG cannot be held responsible for information released or surrender of anonymity due to the in-game actions of the User.

Disclosure:

AG will not otherwise disclose personally identifiable information except to 1) comply with legal requirements of a recognized government agency, 2) protect and defend the rights or property of AG, 3) enforce AG's Terms of Use or Privacy Policy, 4) to perform maintenance and repair of the Service and Site

Merger, Sale, Acquisition or Bankruptcy:

In the event that AG is acquired by or merges with a third party, we reserve the right, in any of these circumstances, to transfer or assign the information we have collected from our Users as part of such merger, acquisition, sale, or other change of control. In the unlikely event of our bankruptcy, insolvency, reorganization, receivership, or assignment for the benefit of creditors, or the application of laws or equitable principles affecting creditors' rights generally, we may not be able to control how your personal information is treated, transferred, or used.

Cookies:

AG may use cookies to store Users' preferences, session information, or other information.

Children Under Age 13:

AG does not allow children under the age of 13 to play AG games and does not collect any such information. In the event that we discern a player is under the age of 13 the account will be suspended and any information already gathered deleted. If you believe an account is used by a child under age 13 please contact us immediately.

Children between 13 and 18:

We recommend that children over the age of 13 obtain permission from a parent or guardian before playing any AG game, or transmitting personal information to the Site or Service.

International Use:

This Site and Service are hosted in the United States of America and intended for US users only, and AG does not authorize use from other locations. If you are nonetheless accessing the Site and Service from the European Union, Asia, or any other region with laws or regulations governing personal data collection, use, and disclosure, that differ from United States laws, please be advised that through your continued use of the Site and Service, which are governed by U.S. law and this Privacy Policy and our Terms of Use, you are transferring your personal information to the United States and you consent to that transfer.
